POOL RULES

The following rules are for the protection and benefit of all residents and guests and are issued to ensure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Please review the rules with your family members and guests and keep them handy to refer to during the season.

- Pool hours are from 8:00am until 10:00pm.
- **NO SMOKING INSIDE THE POOL FENCE AREA.** State Health Department Rules prohibit smoking inside the pool fence area at all times.
- **No glass in the pool fence area.** Only drinks in non-breakable containers are allowed.
- **Pool gate must be closed at all times.** Do not prop the gate open; this is for the safety of our children.
- **No audible music, including but not limited to blasters, boomboxes or stereos, shall be played by an owner's or guest's portable music device.** Please use headphones only.
- **Please remember to lower any umbrella when you leave the pool to prevent wind damage.**
- **No pets are allowed anywhere in the pool fence area.**
- No running, diving, rough play, foul language or boisterous conduct is allowed in the pool area.
- **No spitting of gum or candy on the deck;** the Association has to pay to have it removed.
- All life saving apparatuses must be left in place at all times, except in emergency use. Obey posted signs in the pool area at all times.
- **No food allowed near pool.** Food will be allowed at tables only. Clean up after you eat and dispose of trash and food in the trash receptacles. If this rule is not observed, it will be left to the discretion of the Board to act accordingly to disallow this privilege.
- **Do not leave any items in the pool when you leave the pool for the day, or they may be thrown away.** The use of a float or pool toy is restricted during peak capacity.
- Proper swimming attire is required; no cut-off jeans, etc., as loose strings damage the pump. Baby swim diapers are required inside the pool for all children not potty trained.
- **There is no lifeguard on duty.** Non-swimmers and children under the age of 14 years may not be left at the pool unattended. A parent or guardian is required to be present at all times. You are responsible for your children, your guests and their conduct. You are encouraged not to swim alone.
- **Guests must be accompanied by the homeowner.** Limit guests to the availability of the pool.
- Homeowners will be held responsible for any damage to the pool, pool furniture or equipment. This also applies in cases where damage is caused by your family member or guest.
- Only one pool pass is issued to each home. There is a \$25.00 charge to replace a lost pool pass. If you sell your home, please return your pool pass to Ghertner & Company property management.
- Anyone observed in the pool area after the 10pm closing time will be asked to leave, and if necessary, the police will be called for assistance, which may result in suspension of pool use for the rest of the season.
- Guests are restricted to two (2) per household.
- The pool is open to all residents of Puckett Downs during normal operating hours.

Your pool is inspected regularly by the Health Department as regulated by the State of Tennessee rules and regulations. Your pool is subject to being CLOSED for any violation of these rules. All persons using the pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The Association, its Board of Directors and/or the Management Company assume no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with the use of the pool.
